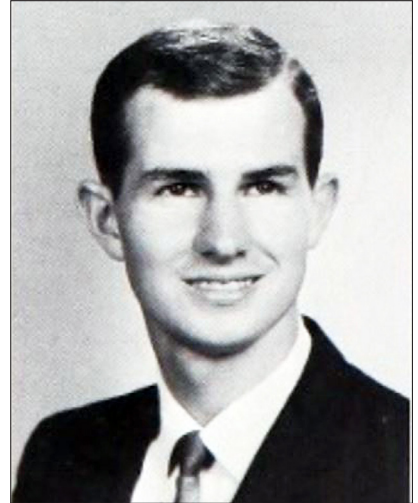

## 2021 Humanitarian Award

### **Rick Claxton '67**

While at CHHS Rick was a baritone in the choir, Choir King, Mr. Howdy, VP of Sophomore Class, President of Student Council, and a member of the Morning Inspiration. One of his classmate's memories of her first day at CHHS was when Rick, as an upper classman, " gave us a winning smile and a warm welcome, helping me and others find their way to class and gave us encouragement."



At Oklahoma State University he received his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration which led to his becoming Director of Human Resources for the American Color Corporation in Phoenix, Executive Director for Printing Industries of Oklahoma & SW Missouri, and for The Mountain States of New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado, & Wyoming. And Rick was working toward his PhD degree in psychology.

His business career consists of leading printing companies to develop and implement business plans and creating solutions for national printing associations. As a human resources analyst he assisted in developing organizational development guides, staffing audits, and assessments/solutions sets.

Rick is known as a dedicated volunteer wherever needed. His volunteering includes Festival of the Arts, Habitat for Humanity, Life Church, founded Count Me in 4 Kids Life Group, Life Launch program for kids aging out of foster care, chaplain for the CHHS Alumni choir, and currently as a board member of the Capitol Hill High School Hall of Fame Association, and the Kiwanis Club of Capitol Hill High School, the only high school club in the nation.

## 2021 JW Mashburn Community Leadership Award

### Roy Vinyard '66



As the third generation of Vinyard family members, Roy's work ethic began early while in elementary school, working in his father's various businesses, who had followed his father in the marketing of food items. Roy attended Heronville Elementary, Capitol Hill Junior High and Capitol Hill High School where he lettered in football and golf.

Roy's grandfather was the earliest grocer, George Washington Vinyard, with his wife, ran a grocery store at SW 34th & Kentucky where customers were friends and neighbors. Their philosophy then of treating people fairly and with respect, is current today with Roy's and Pam's leadership.

Roy continued working through high school while participating in school activities and sports. After graduation from CHHS, Roy attended both Oklahoma State and Central State Universities, studying general business.

In 1968 he married his high school sweetheart, Pamela Brotherton (a 1967 graduate) and they began working together as a team, and in 1969 they formed their company which provided fresh-cut french fries to local businesses, later expanding to fresh produce, dairy, eggs, and frozen foods. In 1999 Vinyard Fruit and Vegetable Company was the beginning of an expansion which today includes 120 employees who have a 14-year average tenure in the current 85,000 square foot facility. While building their company, their family came first. Their children, Jennifer and Rian, have increased the clan with six grandchildren for Pam and Roy, all of whom have participated in the family business.

Roy has coached little league, was President of Sertoma Club during which time women were invited to serve, was appointed by the City Council to the Board of Directors of Oklahoma Metro Alliance, and is currently president of CHHS Kiwanis Club, board member of CHHS Alumni Association, and a member of Northeast Oklahoma City Healthy Community Collaborative.

# 2021 JW Mashburn Community Leadership Award

## **Pam (Brotherton) Vinyard '67**

Pam and Roy have been nominated for this honor by multiple friends and family.

Pam earned a cosmetology license at CHHS and was active in Ki Yi Pep Club. After graduation in 1967, she studied General Business at Central State University and became office manager for Retail Merchants Collection Agency. After Pam and Roy were married in 1968, they formed their company early in a 20 x 10-foot building with a 1967 GTO as their delivery truck. Pam has managed the financials, including the processing of hundreds of invoices and deliveries daily, employing nice people and making lots of good friends along the way.



Serving customers was their priority and their double dates with other couples sometimes included a necessary delivery to a customer. When Roy went to Mercy Hospital to collect his wife and new-born child, their trip home included a delivery to Sirloin Stockade in Edmond to keep Roy's promise of an on-time delivery to his customer. During their many years in the food industry they have made friends within the transporting produce industry, both locally and nationwide.

Pam raised the children while also working at Vinyard Fruit & Vegetable Company, which supplies fresh food and serves four states to distribute over 15 million pounds of fruit & vegetables each year to distributors such as Ben Keith and US Foodservice, and retail outlets, schools, restaurants, hospitals, and casinos.

Pam is currently a member of CHHS Kiwanis Club, Sertoma Club of which she was the first female president, Carl Albert PTA, and Carl Albert Cheerleaders booster club sponsor. She is professionally affiliated with United Fresh Produce Association, and GFSI Safe Quality Foods with level 2 Certification.



# 2021 Lifetime Achievement Award

## Joe Settlemyres '61



JOE IS ONE OF OKLAHOMA'S MOST PROLIFIC AND CELEBRATED MUSICIANS.

At the age of 14, Joe began playing guitar professionally! While at CHHS he led the Swing Band and played upright bass with the orchestra. Dr. Melvin Lee taught him music theory during study hall. On weekends, Joe was on the road with the Red Foley and the Ozark Jubilee Band.

After graduation, he went on the road with Merle Lindsay and traveled with the Grand Ole Opry Show throughout the United States. One of his prestigious gigs was with Bob Wills and his Texas Playboys. At the age of 19, when Tag Lambert became ill, and at his request, the band bus

drove to Guthrie to pick up Joe, and the rest becomes history. Joe became known as the "Youngest Texas Playboy".

Before being drafted by the Army in 1967, and serving as a Marine in the Viet Nam War, Joe played with Willie Nelson, Loretta Lynn, Red Foley, and Tex Ritter. His music helped him through the Tet Offensive and Battle of Hue. When he returned home, he continued his teaching, playing, and learning. After teaching at Oklahoma Christian College, he formed a permanent connection with the University of Science and Arts. His students have gone on to play with Merle Haggard, George Strait, Neil Diamond, Restless Heart, the Judds, Charlie Hall, Hayes Carll, and others.

He is well known for his technical prowess on the guitar. He's a complete musician, has written arrangements for thousands of songs and passed his musical legacy to hundreds of aspiring guitar players through his private instruction.

Joe's contribution to American music has been recognized by 12 Halls of Fame and in 2006 the Oklahoma State Legislature honored him for his 50 years of contribution and dedication to both the Oklahoma music industry and music education in the private and public sectors. He never forgot Dr. Lee and how his years at CHHS instilled in him the desire to learn and to grow as a musician and as a person, and Joe has supported our current Music Department by donating instruments.
